

Mission Senior Secondary Study Block Criteria

Grade 12 students will be considered for study blocks under the following circumstances:

All applicants must have:

- *exemplary attendance
- *good work habits and grades
- *a minimum of 64 credits at the end of grade 11
- *3 academic courses in one semester of grade 12

AND submit the application form with:

- *parent's approval
- *copy of your timetable
- *email from counselor in support of the application
- *email from teacher reference in support of the application

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

In order to support student learning, we permit a limited number of senior students to have study blocks in their timetables. Students on study are responsible for using this time wisely. Study blocks are school time, and while they are not directly supervised, students are expected to be in a designated study area on campus. If they must leave the campus during a study block, they are expected to seek parent permission and sign out at the office.

GRADE 12 CRITERIA

Students must be registered at MSS in three University approved academic courses in the semester they are requesting the study bock. Below is the list of acceptable courses:
